The Lovelock Classic will commence at 1.30pm with Field events, 2.00pm with track events with the Lovelock Mile being run at 2.30pm. ANZ 10,000m Championship event will begin at 5.15pm with programme of race times coming out as entries close.

The Lovelock Mile First Placegetter will receive Prize Money of \$600.00,

- The race has an added incentive of an extra \$400.00 if the first placegetter goes under the 4:00.0 minute mile. Sponsored by Milward Finlay Lobb.

The Women's Mile First Placegetter will receive Prize Money of \$600.

- The race has an added incentive of an extra \$400.00 if the first placegetter goes under the 4:30.0 minutes.

Entries close 11.45pm Tuesday 6th January 2026.

To compete in the Lovelock Classic, and athlete shall be aged 15 years or over on the 31st December 2026 and have achieved the required senior, junior or youth standard in the event they wish to compete in.

Late registrations will only be accepted at the Control Room on the day, closing at 12.00pm, and only if there is space available in the event. Late entries **will incur a late registration fee of \$20.00 on top** of Registration Fee and Event Entry Fee.

Field Events are Open Grades, throwing implements will be the Senior weights. An Athlete can only enter 2 throwing events on the day due to high numbers. If throwing events have large numbers throws will be limited to 3 throws per athlete. **Long Jump** - if the field event has large numbers, jumps will be limited to 3 jumps per athlete.

Track Events

- **Sprint Events** will have an A, B or C Grade, season's best times must be given on registering.
- **Long Distance** – all age grades will compete together.
- **Lovelock Mile** – seeding applies – A Grade maximum of 16 entrants then B grade race

If using own implements for throwing, implements must be calibrated by 12 noon, they will then go into the pool of implements to be used.

Para athletes are asked to contact the Committee to advise of their entry.

Athletes must sign in at Control Room from 12.30pm, to collect their Competition Number and programme.

All Athletes must wear either their correct Club Uniform or Sponsorship Gear, no civvies to be competed in.

Prize Money will be paid directly into the winners Bank Account – please supply bank account details to the Control Room if you are a recipient of a prize.
